Receipts about 70 slaughter steers, 25 slaughter heifers and the balance mainly cows. A sharply lower dressed trade primary factor in this week's decline. Well-finished steers over 1200 lbs. under most pressure. Several loads steers around 1100 lbs or below purchased for further feeding.
