

Bluegrass music festival set

BALTIMORE, Md. — The bluegrass music festival with bands and individuals competing for cash prizes because of the increased number of performers, music will start Sunday, June 10th, is the date for the 20th Deer Creek Fiddlers Convention, featuring old time and

at noon (moved up from the previous 2 o'clock starting hour). The festival is located about 30 miles north of Baltimore near Norrisville, Maryland. South from Norrisville you travel one mile east on Harkins Road (which is route 136); turn left and travel one mile north on Carea Road; turn right and travel one mile east on Channell Road. After coming down into the valley and crossing a small bridge, turn right immediately (just before the new church) to enter the convention grounds. Admission at the gate is \$5; children (of any age up to 95 years) with their parents are free. This encourages family participation. A bluegrass and old time music festival is a family affair.
