

(Continued from Page 1) felt not just in dollar volume, but also in jobs, Heim emphasized more than once that "agriculture keeps Pennsylvania going."

He added that Governor Thornburgh is aware of that fact and there is an orchestrated effort in Harrisburg to insure high priority for farming.

Heim also repeatedly stressed the need for more promotional efforts, mixing those remarks with congratulatory comments to the groups and individuals who were responsible for the Agricultural Exposition. "We have a good product, we need to promote," the deputy agriculture secretary concluded.

Mrs. Robert Kopfer of Fleetwood, speaking for the Farmers' Association, reviewed the activities with obvious delight when she was interviewed by Lancaster Farming later in the week. She said the crafts were very well received and both adults and children were interested in the numerous displays About a dozen groups took part in the educational program.


