Active, feeder steers over 600 lb. strong to 1.00 higher; feeder heifers over 500 lb. steady to strong; steers under 600 lbs. and heifers

under 500 lb. poorly tested early; majority receipts Choice and Mixed Good and Choice 600-900 lb. feeder steers and 500-750 lb. feeder heifers; most of these in moderate flesh but numerous loads arriving from lush grass in moderate to fleshy condition. Some calves are on the yards but these will sell later in the day.

FEEDER STEERS: Choice, few Prime, 500-600 lb. 84.50-90.00; 600-700 lb. 79.00-84.00, Package 614 lb. at 85.25 and shipment 110 head 645 lb. at 86.20; 700-800 lb. 75.50-79.50, packaged 739 lb. at 81.25; 800-950 lb. 71.25-76.00; Mixed Good and Choice 600-700 lbs. 75.75-78.50; 700-1000 lb. 70.00-73.75.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Choice, few Prime, 500-600 lb. 74.00-76.00, package 546 lb. 81.50; 600-700 lb. 71.00-76.00; 700-760 lb. 70.00-72.25 package 762 lb. at 74.60; mixed Good and Choice 500-600 lb. 72.25-74.00; 600-700 lb. 69.50-70.25; Few Good 590-818 lb. 67.60-70.25.

FOR THE WEEK: Compared to late last week, feeder steers under 600 lb. and feeder heifers under 500 lb. 4.00-6.50 higher; feeder steers over 600 lb. and feeder heifers over 500 lb. 3.00-4.00 higher; Cows lost part of the early advance to close steady to .50 higher with some additional weakness noted late; Late sales Utility and Commercial 2-3 49.75-53.75; Cutter 1-3 49.00-52.00; bulls unevenly steady, late sale YG 1-2, 1000-1600 lb. 62.00-67.75; one at 70.75. Salable receipts near 28,000 head for the week compared to 4306 for the holiday shortened period last week and compares with 31,387 the comparable week a year ago. Cows and bulls numbered near 1800 head and comprised 6 per cent of the salable supply; feeders made up 94 per cent of the total.

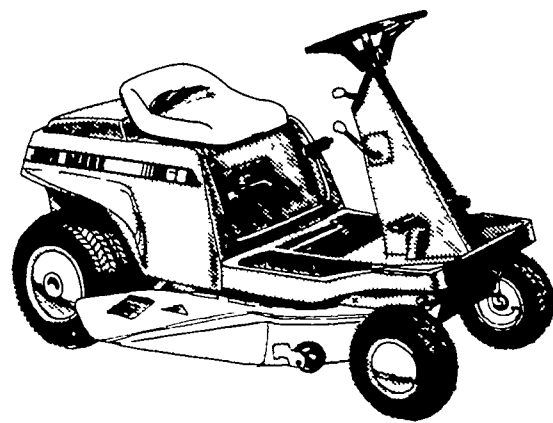
