Through midweek, prices on slaughter steers were .50-.75 lower and Heifers .75-1.00 lower, however limited late sales of Choice 3 Steers and Heifers were near steady Cows were 2.00-4.00 lower and bulls weak to 1.00 lower

Four day receipts 15,900 compared 10.000 for three days last week and 14,600 a year ago.

Fed Cattle prices were forced downward in early trading under the combined influence of rather liberal marketings and a lower trend in a slow-moving carcass trade. Only a portion of the early decline was regained in midweek trading as supplies contracted, and carcass prices firmed, but closing trade was active. Yield Grade was often a major price-determining factor with best demand for choice yield grade 3. The overall finish of the Steer and Heifer supply was again attractive with a liberal percentage Choice although many were mixed Yield Grade 3 and 4, and several consignments predominantly 4 1200-1400 lbs. Slaughter Steers made up approximately 55 pct and Heifters 31 pct. cows comprised 12 pct, feeders scarce.


