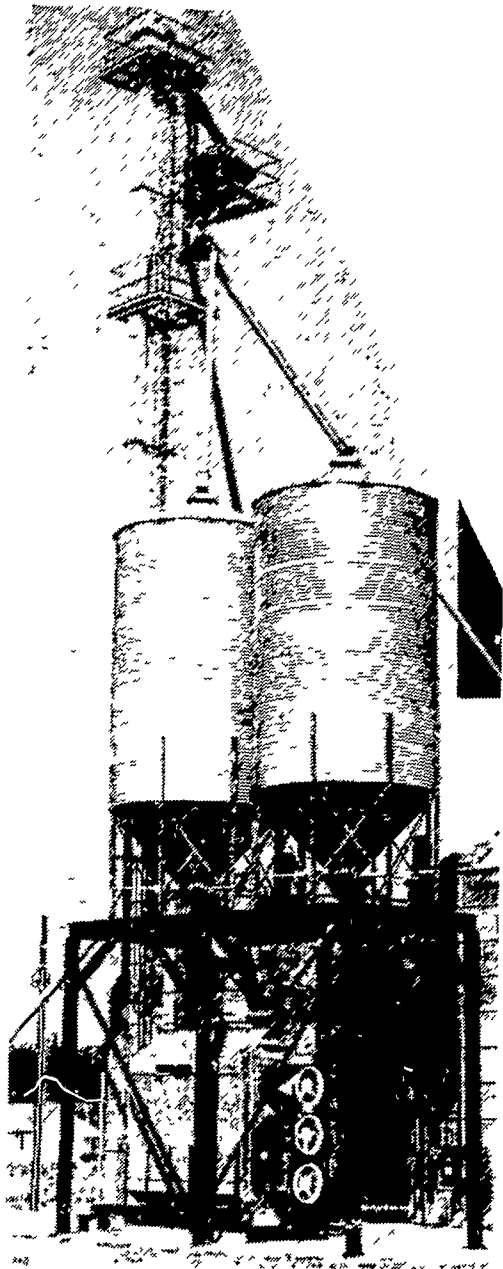

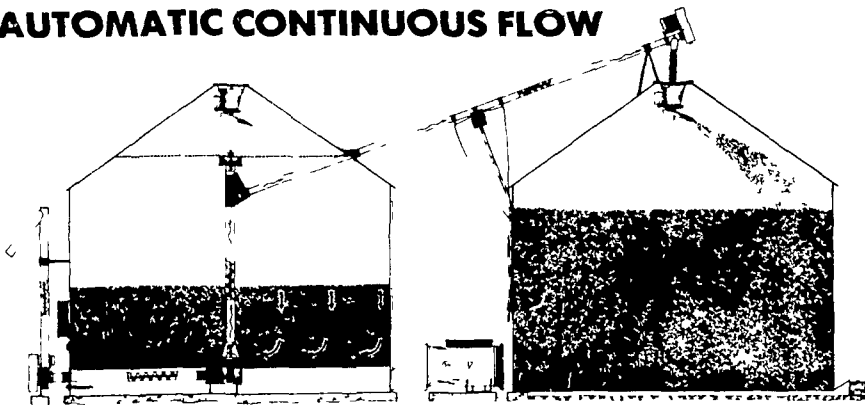

## Del. Field Day to be Aug. 8

NEWARK, Del - Farm and Home Field Day at the University of Delaware's Georgetown Substation has been scheduled for August 8, this year. This annual event gives farmers and non-farmers alike a chance to observe what the University's Agricultural Experiment Station and the Cooperative Extension Service are doing for the people who live in Delaware. Activities will begin at 9:30 a.m. During the day, there will be special wagon and

bus tours of corn and soybean, vegetable, and poultry projects around the Substation, as well as tours of the University swine facilities. There will be a plant clinic where farmers and home gardeners can bring plant problems for diagnosis by a panel of experts. There will also be a number of consumer education exhibits, many of them emphasizing home and family life. (Note: The consumers' program will be held in the grove this year.)

At noon a traditional fried chicken luncheon will be served in the farm grove by members of the Delaware Poultry Improvement Association. And refreshments will be on sale during the day at a stand run by Sussex county 4-H leaders.

Field Day will conclude at 3:30 p.m. with free watermelon for all those in attendance.

The Substation is located 6 miles west of Georgetown on the Laurel-Georgetown Highway (Route 9).

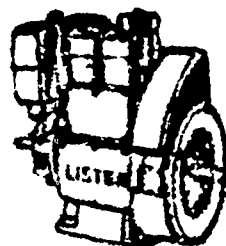

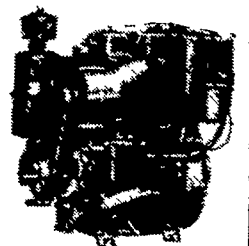
