Moderate demand for packer trades as most packers are finding it more advantageous to purchase carcasses rather than live cattle. Bulk steer of movement in the midwest and southwest with Chicago and eastern outlets reporting adequate inventories and slow movement. Sales reported on 61 loads of steer and heifer beef.

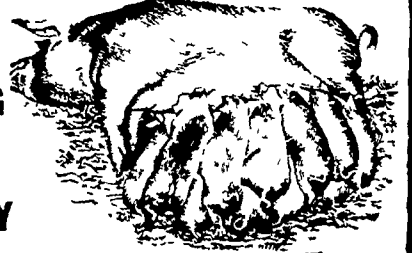
