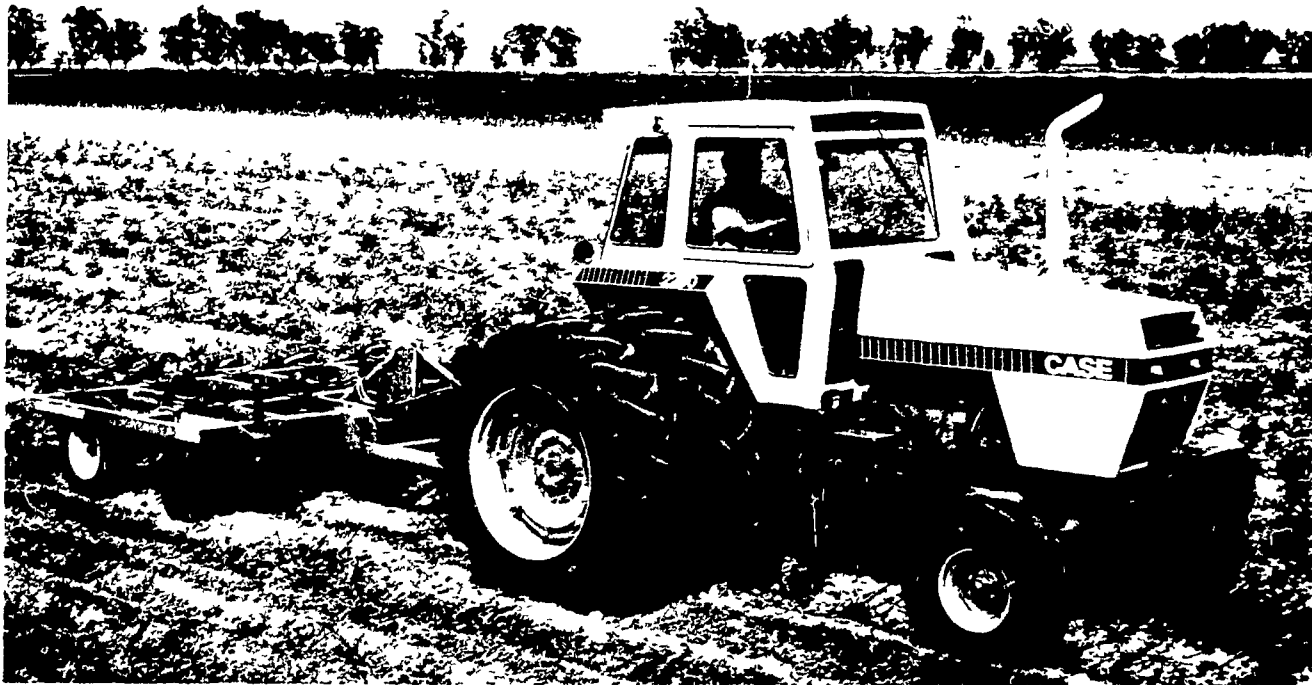

## License revoked

NEW YORK, N.Y. - Marketing Service charged Shippers Distributing Co., Inc., Washington, D.C., has had its Perishable Agricultural Commodities Act license revoked for failing to make full payment promptly for produce worth \$61,154 and failing to remit net proceeds of \$8,159 for the sale of produce on consignment. PACA, administered by U.S. Department of Agriculture officials, establishes a code of good business conduct for the produce industry.

The firm may not conduct business under PACA until June 15, 1981, and then only if a PACA license is obtained. The firm's officers, directors, and major stockholders--Tom G. Pappas, Ms. Jacqueline Pappas, and Ms. Alea Pappas--may not be employed by any PACA license until June 15, 1980, and then only if the employer post a surety bond and USDA approves.

Officials with the department's Agricultural

Marketing Service charged the firm with failing to make full payment promptly for fruits and vegetables worth \$61,154, shipped from February 1978 through February 1979. The firm also failed to give true and correct account, and to make full payment promptly for net proceeds of \$8,159 for produce handled on consignment during September, October, and November, 1978. The department ruled that based on the evidence, the firm had committed willful, flagrant, and repeated violations of the act.

Under PACA, all interstate traders in fresh and frozen fruits and vegetables must be licensed by USDA. USDA is authorized to suspend or revoke a trader's license for violating the act.
