Bulls Weak to 1.00 lower. Slaughter supply mainly Choice and Mixed Choice and Prime 2-4 1050-1250 lb. Steers with several lots 3-4 over 1150 lbs., around 35 per cent heifers and 15 per cent cows.

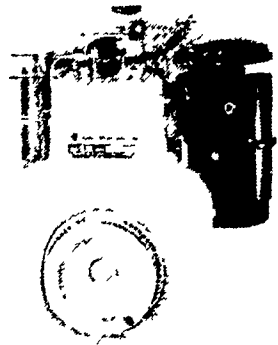

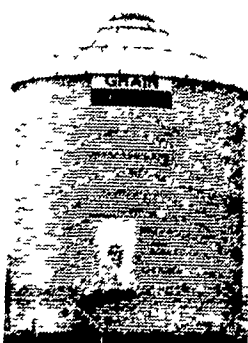
