run included a number of loads 3-5 1250-1400 lb. steers as well as a sprinkling of good and choice 975-1050 lb. new crop steers. Overall, there was a fairly liberal percentage of choice steers and heifers. Steers made up approximately 48 pct and heifers 34 pct. Cows comprised 14 pct with feeders scarce.
