As compared to last week's close, slaughter steers and heifers 2.00-3.00 lower. Cows 5.00-8.00 lower, most decline on Utility and Commercial. Bulls 1.00 lower. Slaughter supply near 50 percent steers, 35 percent heifers and about 15 percent cows. Numbers of Choice and Prime 3-4 steers and heifers down substantially compared last few weeks.

Additional price declines in wholesale beef trading early in the week and a very sluggish movement of beef into retail channels ap-

peared to be factors accounting for the latest declines in live prices.

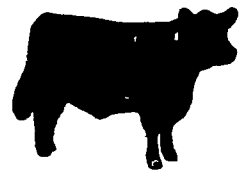
