There were five age divisions in the showmanship competition. First place winners in each division were: Darren Weaver, Hershey, 10 years and younger; Ed Huntzberger, Elizabethtown, 11-13 years; Rick Weaver, Berrysburg, 14-15 years; Demise Halke, Halifax, 16 years and Roy

Stohecker, Millersburg, 17 years and older.

There were a total of 24 exhibitors and 79 hogs were sold at the auction. The average price without the champion was 47.5 cents per pound. Including the champion, the average price was 50.4 cents per pound.

The judge for the show was Mark Nestleroth of RD 5 Manheim. He is the co-owner of Dutch Valley Farms.



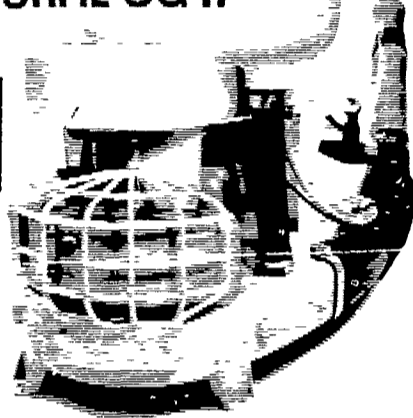
