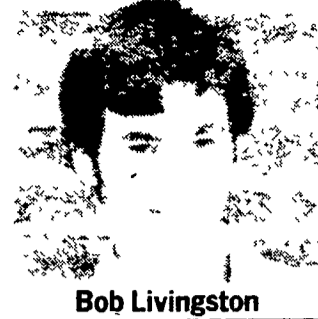
More honors came when a York County demonstration team checked in with a first place. Team members were Kay Swartz of Hanover, and

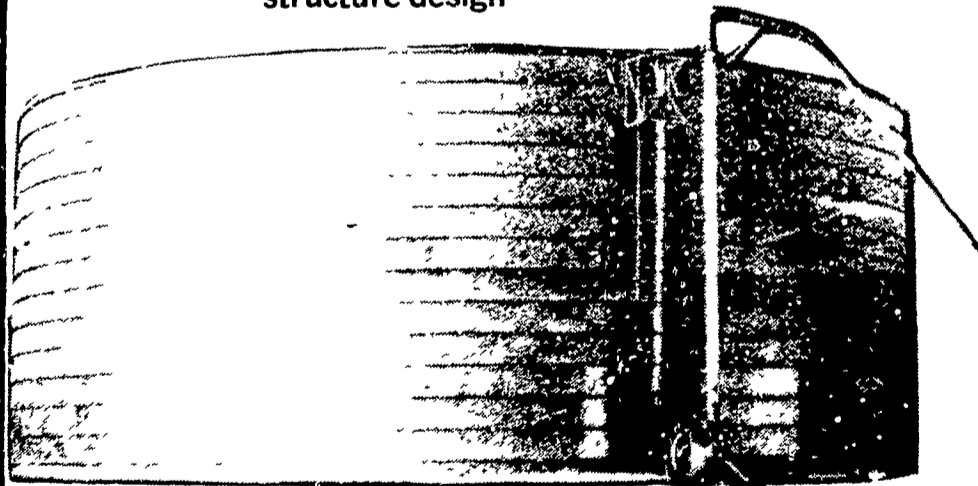
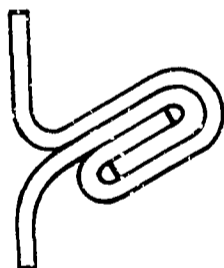

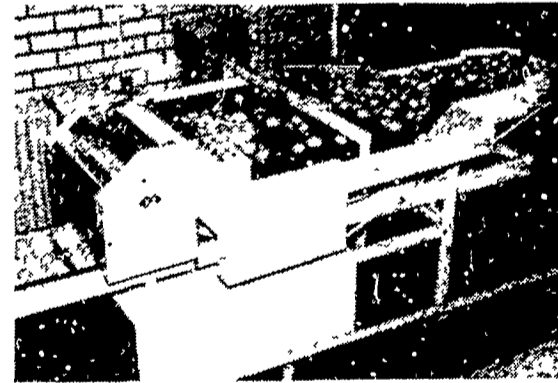
