

Pa. hunting licenses are now on sale

HARRISBURG — Pennsylvania hunting and trapping licenses for 1979-80 seasons are on sale throughout the commonwealth. The new licenses will be valid from September 1, 1979, through August 31, 1980.

Licenses are available from county treasurers and local issuing agents. They are also available by mail or in person from the Pennsylvania Game Commission, License Section, P. O. Box 1567, Harrisburg, PA 17120.

The cost of a resident license for youngsters 12 through 16 years of age is \$5.25; a resident adult license for hunters 17 through 64 years of age costs \$8.25; adult licenses for resident senior citizens 65 years of age and older cost \$5.25 each; the cost of a nonresident license, regardless of age, is \$50.50; an archery license costs \$2.20; and a flintlock muzzleloader license costs \$3.25.

Hunters are reminded that persons applying for Pennsylvania resident hunting licenses need positive "proof" of residency. Since many nonresidents have motor vehicle operator's licenses from Pennsylvania, a state "driver's license" is

not necessarily considered to be positive "proof" of residency.

The following can be used to establish "proof" of residency: (a) a current Pennsylvania motor vehicle registration card; (b) tax receipts evidencing payment of Pennsylvania state income tax, earned income tax, or other tax receipts evidencing payment of personal taxes required of commonwealth residents; (c) a Pennsylvania operator's license when presented with other identification showing a corresponding Pennsylvania address; or (d) some other positive means of verifying residency.

The 1979-80 Pennsylvania Hunting and Trapping Digest is now available and is being issued with each hunting license.

The 52-page booklet contains information on 1979-80 seasons and bag limits, maps and dates for special hunting areas, a general summary of hunting laws and regulations, and numerous other items of interest to sportsmen.

Each hunter should be sure to obtain a Digest when he or she purchases a hunting license.

office at (304) 267-7375 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. weekdays. The service, which will continue until mid-September, is updated each afternoon at about 2:00 p.m. with the previous day's shipments and that day's F.O.B.'s.

Also, the service will report on apples from early this September until April of

next year.

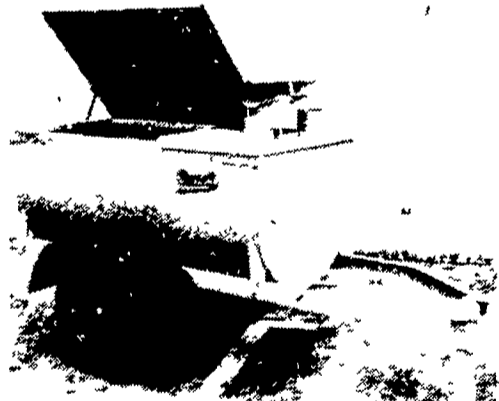
