

# Southeastern FFA dairy show held at Kutztown

KUTZTOWN—The twenty-fourth annual Southeastern Regional FFA District Dairy Show was held August 21 at the Kutztown Fair Grounds. Entered were a total of 193 animals, which converged from nine southeastern Pennsylvania counties. Michael Fulmer, 20, from Eastern Northampton FFA showed Juniperdale Pen Star to win the grand championship of the Holstein

show. This two year old was sired by Bond Haven Royal Star.  
Taking the reserve grand champion honors was R. Steven Kauffman, 17, of Elizabethtown. Steven's champion was a three year old named Penn-Spring's R Maple Dimples, sired by Citation R. Maple.  
Grand champion exhibitors from other breeds were: Kennard Henley III, of Octorara FFA - Aryshire; Gary Lee Mase, of Annville-

Brown Swiss; Robert Kirk, of Solanco - Guernsey; Marilyn Deaven, of Northern Lebanon - Jersey; and Nedra Yoder, of Hamburg - Milking Shorthorn.  
Marvin Fox, of Cloister FFA took champion honors in the fitting show for ninth and tenth grade students. First place honors for showmanship were awarded to Steven Shaw, of Oley. In the eleventh and twelfth grade class fitting honors were awarded to Penny

Bicksler, of Tulpehocken, while showmanship honors went to Steve Kauffman, of Elizabethtown. Ed Brightbill, of Oxford, received awards for fitting and showmanship in the graduate class.
