

# Maryland Fashion Revue winners named

TIMONIUM, Md.—Montgomery county's two representatives finished first and second in the 4-H Fashion Revue, held August 31 at the Maryland State Fair in Timonium. Both young women are from the Gaithersburg area.

Colleen Kirchoff, 18, a resident of Goshen. The runnerup is Linda Rudy, 17 who lives in Rosemont, southeast of Gaithersburg. As state Fashion Revue winner, Colleen is now eligible to represent Maryland during the National 4-H Congress, held

each year in late November at Chicago, Ill. She is the third consecutive Montgomery county teen-ager to earn this recognition. In winning the state contest, Miss Kirchoff modeled an off-white tailored suit of 100 percent polyester which she had

made as a demonstration garment for the grand opening at a new location of the fabric shop where she works. She wore a contrasting semi-fitted blue blouse. Her rise to the state championship climaxed an eight-year effort of self-

improvement which should serve as an inspiration to younger 4-H members. It wasn't until this year that she finished in the top 10 in the annual Montgomery county 4-H Fashion Revue. Besides sewing, Colleen has been enrolled in junior leadership, foods and nutrition, consumer judging, photography, crafts, and horse and pony 4-H projects. She had previously placed high at the Maryland State Fair in both 4-H consumer judging and in performance classes of the 4-H horse and pony show, involving jumping over fences.

Placing third in the state 4-H Fashion Revue this year was Kathy Oles, 19, of Florence (Howard county). She modeled a four-piece blue ski ensemble. Glori Stifler, 17, of Glen Arm (Baltimore county) was fourth with a wool and polyester pantsuit. Karen L. Ricketts, 16, of Myersville (Frederick county) placed fifth. She wore a cotton and polyester pantsuit.

Five special awards are given to contestants in the state 4-H Fashion Revue, based on selections by the participants themselves. Winners in these categories were as follows: Best model—Amy L. Mathis, Sykesville; Best groomed—Linda Rudy, Gaithersburg; Most congenial—Cheryl Morgan, Frostburg; Best accessorized—Kathy Oles, Florence; Best selection—Glori Stifler, Glen Arm.

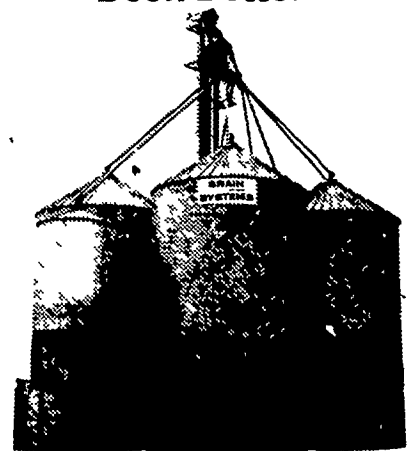
