

Farmers' Association sponsors mobile health testing van

YORK—The York County Farmers' Association is sponsoring the visit of a mobile health testing van beginning Monday, October 1. The van is sponsored as a part of a statewide drive by

the farmers to bring medical care to rural areas.

The mobile unit will be located at Dairyland Square in Red Lion. The unit has been traveling throughout Pennsylvania offering low cost comprehensive examinations to the rural

and urban population who would otherwise, not have the opportunity. The van is staffed by a team of five paramedical technicians and a registered nurse.

The unit offers chest X-rays, audiometry, electrocardiograms, lung func-

tion tests, breast examinations, eye tests, blood chemistry, hematology, urinalysis, tuberculosis, skin tests and various other examinations. The complete exam is done in 45 minutes.

The purpose of this program is to make each county resident aware of the need for a medical examination to prevent illness. The cost of this service is reasonable. A special telephone number will be established for those countians interested in the examination.

A representative of the American Health Profiles, Inc. will be in the York area on September 20 and will conduct a meeting to teach volunteers how to make appointments. Volunteers

will work in a telephone room which will be located near the site of the van. Appointments will need to be made three or four days prior to the arrival of the van.

The York County Farmers

Association Womens Committee has arranged for the program because they feel it will be a great benefit to the county people as well as an invaluable aid to physicians in preventive health care.

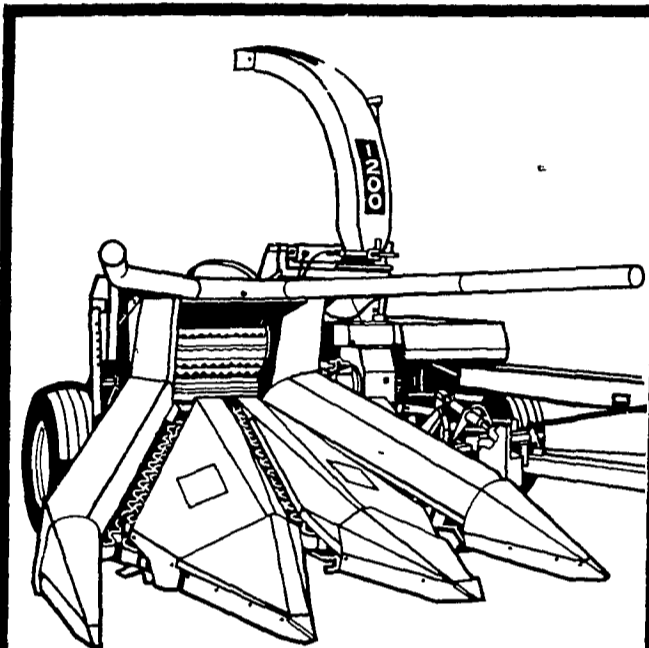
Del. 4-H horse show Sept. 23

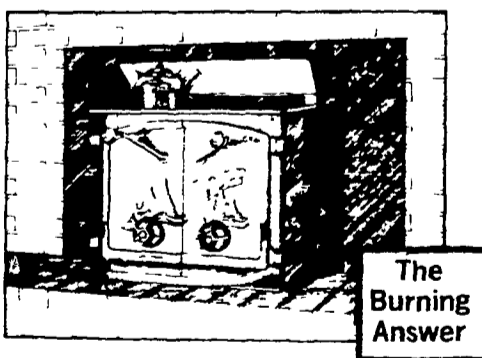
