Mrs. Bollinger is a member of the Institute of Food Technologists, Phi Kappa Phi Honorary Society and Gamma Sigma Delta.

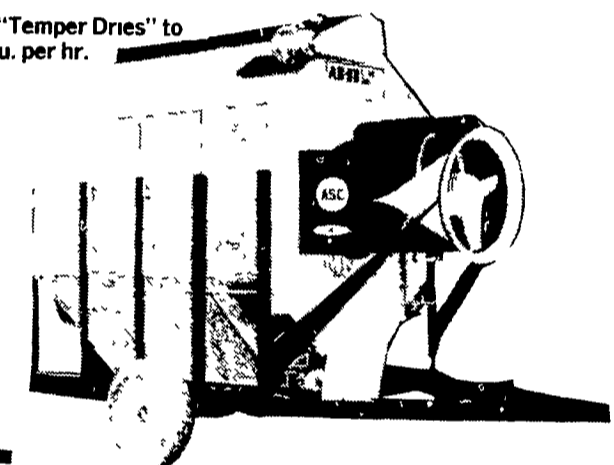
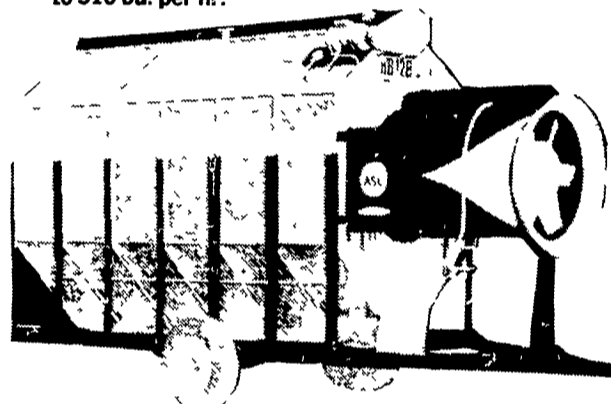
In her new position as produce research analyst, she will be responsible for evaluating Weaver products in such areas as sensory taste panel activities, and physical testing of product.

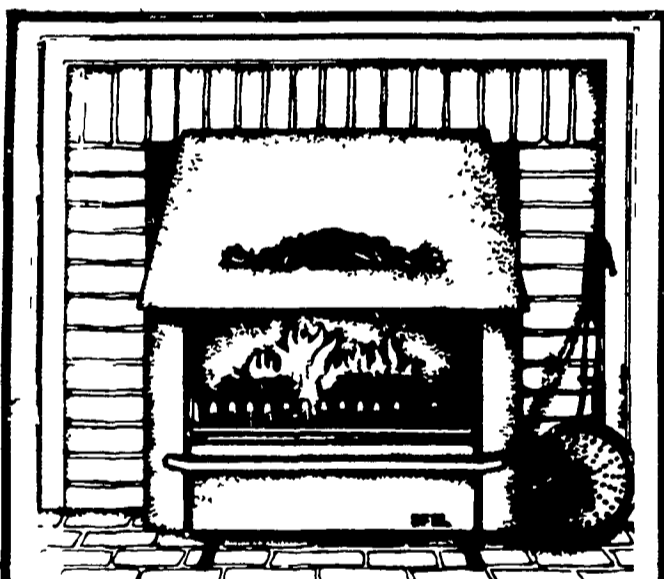
