

## 4-H livestock sale held at Clinton Fair

LOCK HAVEN - Twenty seven animals, including 16 hogs, 6 lambs, and five steers brought a total of \$9,789.44 at the 4-H Livestock Auction held at the Clinton County Fair and 4-H Round-up on Sept. 4.

Thirteen Clinton County 4-H members participated in the sale at the Fairgrounds. William B. Tressler, Mill Hall R3, served as auctioneer.

Greg Connor, Mill Hall R1, showed the Grand Champion steer which was sold to Albright's Feed Mill, Mill Hall R1 for \$1.00 per pound. The animal was a 1259 pound Charolais. The Reserve Grand Champion steer owned by Wade Vonada, Mackeyville, brought the highest price for the sale of a steer at the fair. Crissman's Inc., paid \$1.65 per pound for Vonada's 939 pound Hereford.

The other three steers

were sold as follows: Mike Courter, Mill Hall R2, sold his 1160 pound Charolais to Agway, Inc., Mill Hall; Travis Pick, Mill Hall R3, sold his 939 pound Hereford to Grant Miller Chrysler-Plymouth; and Billy Vonada, Mackeyville, sold his 894 pound Hereford to Harold Bierly's Livestock Dealer.

In the market swine division, the Grand and Reserve Grand Champion hogs were shown by Lyndon Yearick, Mill Hall R2. Both were purchased by the Kermit Yearick Insurance Agency, Mill Hall. The champion weighed 244 pounds and brought \$1.60 per pound and the reserve champion weighed 240 pounds and sold at \$1.50 per pound.

The remaining market hogs in the 4-H Livestock Sale were sold as follows: Greg Connor, Mill Hall R1 -

two hogs - the first to Albright's Feed Mill, Mill Hall and the second to Jersey Shore Livestock Auction.

Red Kolesar, Mill Hall R3, four hogs - the first to Jim Bierly's Meat Market, State College; the second to attorney Merritt E. McKnight, Lock Haven; the third to Penns Valley Livestock Auction, Centre Hall and the fourth to Adam Waltz, Westport.

Kim Connor, Mill Hall R1 - two hogs - one to Keister Livestock Auction, Middleburg, Pa. and the second to Pennsdale Country Store, Pennsdale.

Steve Laubscher, Lock Haven R2, sold his 222 pound hog to Grant Miller Chrysler-Plymouth, Lock Haven.

Larry Laubscher, Lock Haven R2, sold to Glenn Bechdel, Woodman of the World, Insurance Agency.

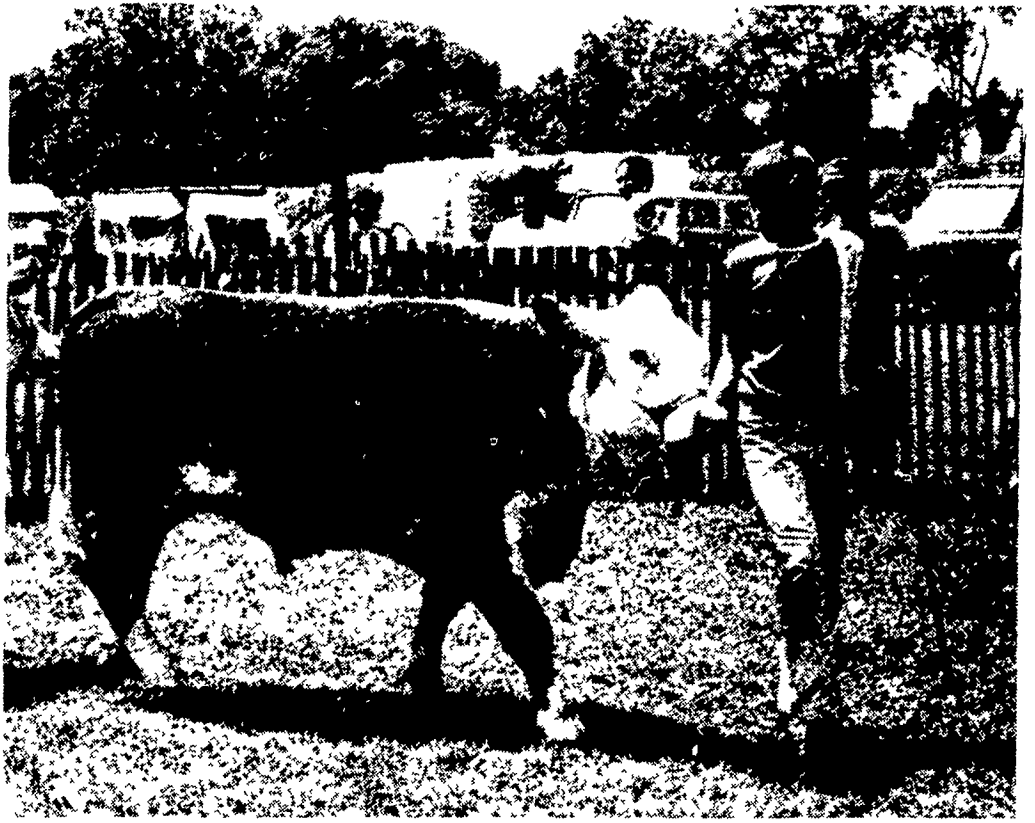
Kristen Laubscher, Lock Haven R2, to Fritz McGrail of Webb's Super Gro, Mill Hall.

The grand champion market lamb weighed 91 pounds and was purchased by Paul Dotterer, Mill Hall R1, for \$2.07 per pound from Greg Connor. The reserve champion lamb, owned by Kim Connor, weighed 99 pounds and was purchased by Crissman's Inc., Lock Haven for \$1.55 per pound.

Other market lambs were: Scott Plotts, Lock Haven R1 to Paul Dotterer, Mill Hall R1; Greg Connor, Mill Hall R1 to Paul Dotterer; Kim Connor, Mill Hall R1 to Elwin Ream, Vigortone Products, Hughesville; Steve Lachat, Mill Hall R1 to Keister's Livestock Auction, Middleburg.

The sale averages without the Grand and Reserve

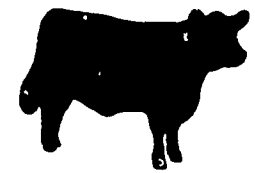

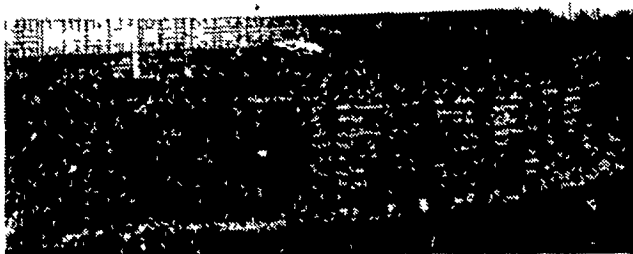
