

Solanco Fair receives \$5,000 in matching funds

QUARRYVILLE - The Southern Lancaster County Community Fair received a check for \$5,000 in matching funds from the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture's Fair Fund, in ceremonies held on the fairgrounds on Quarryville.

The \$5,000 check, for the construction of a pole barn, was presented by James Sumner, Director of the

Bureau of Markets, Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture. The funds were made available through a special allocation of the Pennsylvania State Fair Fund, aimed at promoting capital improvements at fairgrounds with the Commonwealth.

Sumner said that county fairs are important to agriculture. "They are a

way for farmers to compete with other farmers to improve the quality of our crops and livestock. At the same time, fairs provide a great opportunity to promote a better understanding of farm life and rural Pennsylvania," he said.

The Pennsylvania State Fair Fund is funded by returns from horse and harness racing revenues. In

addition to this year's matching funds program, another \$1.9 million has been earmarked for distribution to the 107 fairs in the state to cover costs of events exhibitions and premiums for 1978.

Including this year's matching funds, the Southern Lancaster County Community Fair received a total of \$14,735 from the Fair

Fund this year. the 100th District also State Representative participated in the Gibson E. Armstrong from ceremonies.
