Babcock creates new poultry health position

ITHACA, N.Y. — Robert C. Wellenstein has been appointed to the newly-created position of viroimmunologist in the poultry health department at Babcock Poultry Farm, Inc. in Ithaca, New York.

According to Dr. Robert F. Ball, poultry health manager for the primary breeder of egg-type poultry, his primary responsibilities will include the development of new immunological approaches to disease diagnosis and prevention.

Wellenstein had previously worked as a supervising technician for the Diagnostic Laboratory of the New York State College

of Veterinary Medicine at Cornell University in Ithaca. A Richfield Springs, New York native with a dairy farm background, he was graduated from Cornell in 1973 with a BS in Biology, with a genetics concentration. Subsequently, he completed a number of advanced veterinary virology courses at Cornell, and a six-week intensive training program in immunology from the USDA.

Wellenstein resides with his wife and daughter in Newfield, New York.
