LOUISVILLE, Ky. - The North American International Livestock Exposition held here will be the site of national activities for the American Shorthorn Association as it conducts its annual meeting and National

will be given to Shorthorn and Polled Shorthorn producers at the evening banquet with the presentation of awards that will include Sire of the Year, Century Club winners, Junior Breeder of the Year and the announcement of the three recipients of the Shorthorn Foundation-Don Longley Memorial Scholarships to members of the American Junior Shorthorn Association.

A record number of 300 head of cattle from the top competitive herds of Shorthorns and Polled Shorthorns across this country area expected to compete for top honors November 12 and 13 in this popular show. The National Shorthorn Show will be using a three man composite judging system for the first time with Roger Hunsley, Purdue University; Miles McKee; Kansas State University; and Joe Woods, Frankfort, In., serving as the team officials.

The National Shorthorn Lassies, the women's auxiliary of the association, will be having their national annual meeting the same dates.

A business meeting is scheduled for November 12 in the West Hall of the Kentucky Exposition Center. Agenda highlights, Hofstrand said, will include the election of national officers and the filling of the three directors' seats whose terms expire.

The meeting will also host the crowning of the National Shorthorn Lassie Queen at the annual banquet. According to Wilma Russell, Fullerton, Ne., coordinator of the event, 16 young ladies will vie for the national crown now worn by Mary McLaughlin, Woodsfields, Oh.

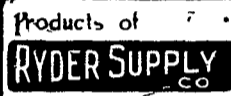

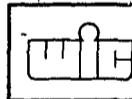
