The forestry skills contests were held on Tuesday evening.

In the tree falling contest, Roger Reich placed second, Larson Herman, third, Barry Waite, fourth, and Tim Reich, Twelfth

In axe chopping, Tim

In the chain sawing Contest, Darrell Wagner placed seventh, Tim Reich, ninth, Larson Herman, tenth, and Clair McKnight, eleventh.

In the two-year-old, never fresh class, Jacke Beaver won a first place.

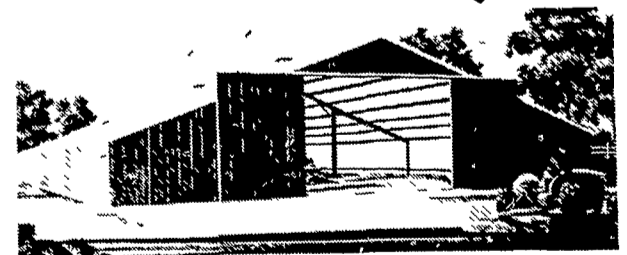
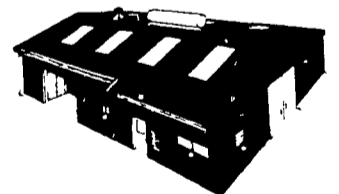
