

Delmarva Poultry meeting slated

NEWARK, Del. — All plans have been completed for the 14th National Meeting on Poultry Health and Condemnations. This two-day meeting will be held on Tuesday and Wednesday, October 16 and 17, at Del-Marva Convention Hall in Delmar, Md. It is sponsored by Delmarva Poultry In-

dustry, Inc. in cooperation with the Universities of Delaware and Maryland.

"More than two dozen participants will present the latest findings in this important area of the poultry industry," reports Dr. Gerald W. Albright, general chairman of this event. Albright noted that there were 400

registrants for last year's meeting who came from 25 states, the District of Columbia and four foreign countries. General sessions will be held each morning. On

Tuesday afternoon, there will be two separate sessions, one for grow-out and the other for processing.
