## Ag in action day October 7

FLEMINGTON, N.J. - The harvest of corn for grain and silage is well under way on Hunterdon and Somerset farms. Combines, corn pickers, forage harvesters are working full-tilt to gather the crops.

With harvest in full-swing, tours of several nearby Somerset County farms have been scheduled for Sunday, October 7, from 12 noon to 4:00 p.m.

"Agriculture in Action Day," is sponsored by the Somerset and Hunterdon County Boards of Agriculture and the Cooperative Extension Service.

Held last year for the first time by the Somerset County Board, the affair was very well received. It's aim was to offer the public an opportunity to see first-hand the agricultural practices employed by area farmers in the production of several important commodities. People had the chance to see

and discuss the operations, problems and efforts of the farming community to protect the environment.

Best farms, this year, are Hill-Haven Farm, a large grain and hay operation, Christopher Farm, an excellent hog farm; and Tom Kanach and Sons, a large, progressive, dairy farm.

All are located near Clover Hill, east of Flemington. Direction signs will be at the prominent intersections approaching Clover Hill.

Free wagon tours will make the circuit of the farms. Guides will be on the wagons to describe the operations underway and to answer questions.

There will be demonstrations of field chopping corn for silage, harvesting corn grain, drying and storing grain, hay-making, water and soil conservation practices.
