

# Grand champion steer sells for over \$5 grand

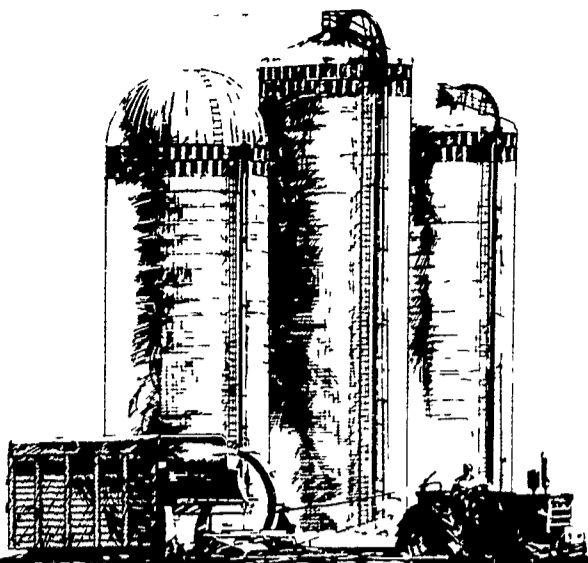

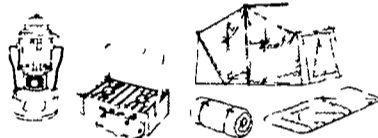

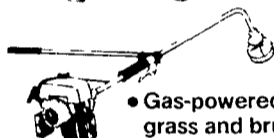
