Nick Moehlmann and Senator Manbeck.

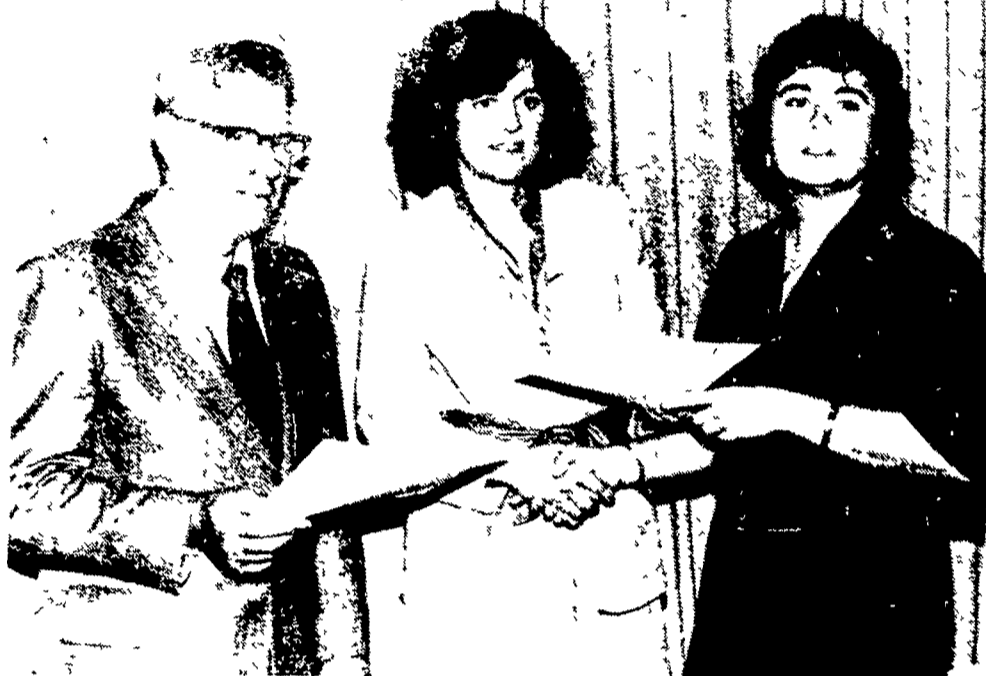

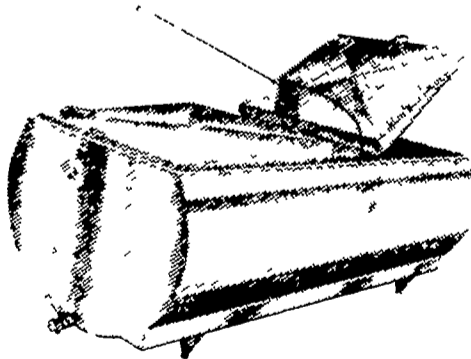
