

Yearling horses awarded to 4-H members

HARRISBURG — Two Pa. 4-H horse club members were selected to be the proud new owners of two Quarter Horse yearlings at the State 4-H horse show, October 5-7.

Jeffrey Brown, 14, of Skinner Creek R1, McKean County, and Kelly Jo Atackowicz, 14, of Eighty Four, R2, Washington County, were the lucky

winners. They were chosen in recognition of their outstanding work and leadership in 4-H, school and in other activities.

According to farmer and sausagemaker Bob Evans, "providing good quality colts to 4-H members who show outstanding leadership qualities is our way of expressing appreciation of the

fine work of the 4-H program."

Evans, raised on a farm, has supported the efforts of young people interested in agriculture and currently serves as a trustee of the Ohio 4-H Foundation.

"Nominations for the award were screened by each 4-H Horse District Committee," says James P. Gallagher, Extension animal scientist at The Pennsylvania State University. Winners were determined by a committee consisting of Penn State College of Agriculture faculty and staff members.

Kelly Jo, a sophomore at the Bentworth High School, has been a 4-H member for seven years and a horse club

member for the past two years. She currently serves as the club's secretary.

Since she has been in 4-H horse club work, she has been showing a mare, "Shady Lady," at local shows and fairs.

"I'm happy to win this award so I can raise a foal that I can call my own and also get started in another ambition of mine, horse breeding," she emphasizes.

Kelly Jo points out that her greatest ambition is to show the animal at the World Championship Quarter Horse Show or the Quarter Horse Congress.

She plans to have the horse trained professionally and begin showing the animal at

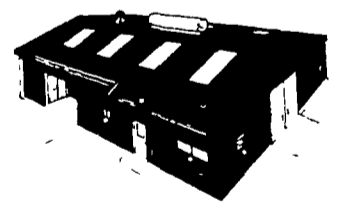

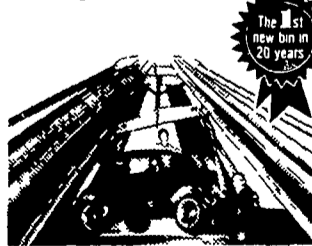

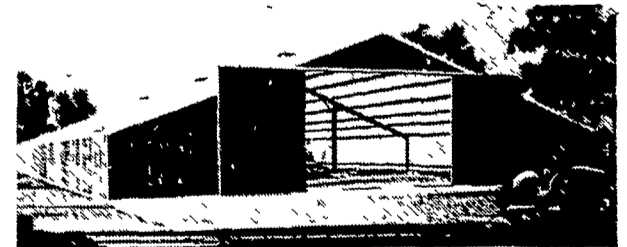
