

Sarah Brubaker shows lamb to reserve grand championship

TIMONIUM, Md. - A 125-pound Hampshire lamb shown by Sarah Brubaker, of Lancaster County, was named Reserve Grand Champion Market Lamb of the 33rd Eastern National Livestock Show held at the Maryland State Fairgrounds.

The lamb was sold following the judging at \$3.50 a pound to Henry W. Stapp, Inc., a meat packing firm from Baltimore.

Sarah also won a second place ribbon in the judging in the 95-105-pound Hampshire class.

Other top winners from Pennsylvania in the lamb judging were:

Barbara Herr, Narvon, first place, 95-105 pound Hampshire, and first place, 100-110 pound Crossbred; Margaret Herr, Narvon, first place, 100-pound Dorset, Cheviot, Southdown,

Montadale, Shropshire and Corriedale class.

In the hog market judging, only one Pennsylvanian figured in the top results. Gus Parlett, of Airville, took second place in the 200-205 pound judging class.

Two Pennsylvanians won first and second place ribbons in the market steer judging.

Ed Klunedist, of Wrightsville, took first place in the lightweight Angus class. Judy Fair, of Harrisburg, won a second place ribbon in the mediumweight other cross steer judging.

All participants in the market livestock classes are members of 4-H Clubs or Future Farmers of America chapters.
