Two hundred sixty trucks, passenger cars, station wagons, and other vehicles

are offered on a "where is, as is" basis. The auction is open to dealers, the general public, and employees of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania with the exception of employees (or their agents) of the Department of General Services and other employees specifically restricted.

Included among the vehicles are AMC Matadors and Hornets; Plymouth Furies, Gran Furies, Valiants, Satellites; Chevrolet Chevelles, etc. There is also a large selection of dump trucks. Fifty-three of the cars are equipped with air conditioning. Most cars are 1974, 1975 and 1976 models with

mileage ranging from 21,123 to 140,266.
