

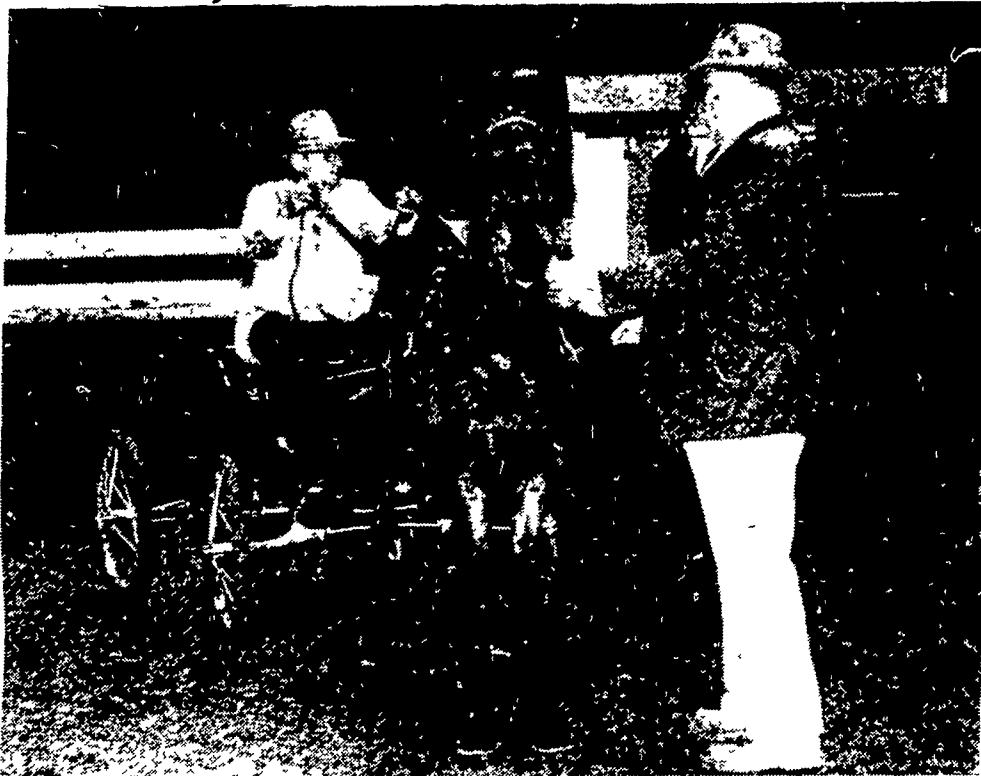
Jay Cawley, of River Ridge Farm, Dauphin, won second place in both the Amateur Owner's Jumper classes held on Tuesday and Wednesday. He

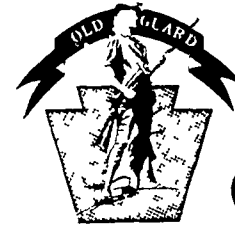

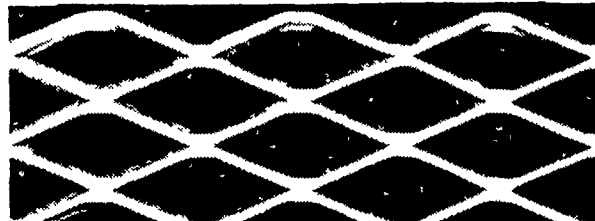
