Compared last weeks close, slaughter steers and heifers 1.00-1.50 higher. Cows weak to 1.00 lower. Bulls 1.00-2.00 lower. Slaughter supply near 50 percent steers, 35 percent heifers and about 15 percent cows.

Reduced marketing locally early in the week, rather than any reported improvement in wholesale beef demand, appeared to be the major factor contributing to the advance in steer and heifer prices.
