Broiler placements down five percent

HARRISBURG — Placements of broiler chicks in the Commonwealth during the week ending November 3, 1979 were 1,856,000, according to the Pennsylvania Crop Reporting Service.

The placements were five percent below the corresponding week a year earlier, and five percent below the previous week. Average placements during the past nine weeks were three percent below a year earlier.

Placements in the 21 key poultry producing states were 60,390,000, 15 percent below the previous week and five percent below the same week a year earlier. Average placements during the past nine weeks were five percent above a year ago.

Broiler-fryers slaughtered in Pennsylvania under federal inspection during the week ending October 24, totaled 2,006,000 with an average liveweight of 4.18 pounds.

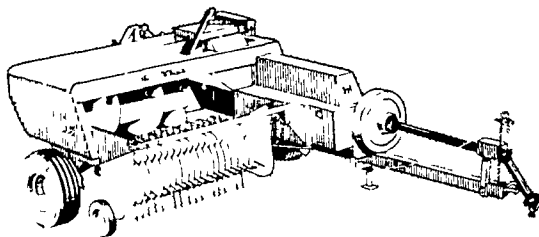

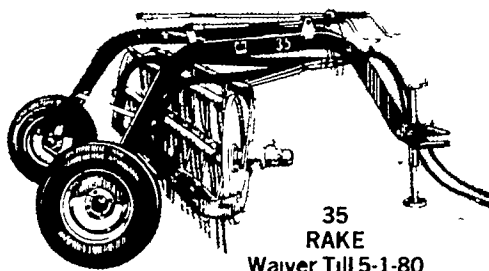

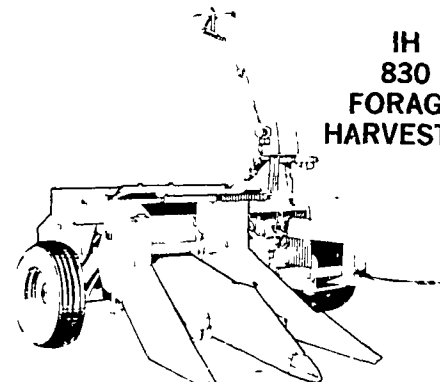
