## Help houseplants adjust to new temperatures

**MEDIA** - Houseplants that have just been brought in-side are probably experiencing some trouble.

Ideally, houseplants should be brought in the first week of September. After this time, night temperatures start to drop (maybe too low for your plants.) Temperatures during the day remain warm. When you finally bring them in, the house temperatures are much warmer than the outside temperatures.

Then, says James J. McKeehan, Delaware County Extension Agricultural Agent, your

plants experience leaf drop. To control this situation, here are a few things to do:

1. If your houseplants aren't already inside - get them in the house.
2. Don't immediately put them in the warmest room. Gradually introduce them to their permanent location.
3. Regular your watering practices to fit the requirements of the plant.

After several weeks, your plants should acclimate themselves. Normal growth should resume.
