The Festival will begin with a craft show set for Friday, November 23rd, 12 to 8 and Saturday, November 24th, 10 to 5 in the dining room of the Senior High School.

The room will be crammed with local and regional craftsmen, displaying and demonstrating their wares. NEWARK, Del. - The Extension Service is in the process of locating existing cooperative and buying clubs in Delaware in order to conduct a survey and case study for the Cooperative League Fund, Washington, D.C.

The purpose of the survey is (1) to determine the number of cooperatives in Delaware, (2) to identify some needs of existing cooperatives to more

adequately serve families, (3) to determine if additional cooperatives are needed to serve Delaware citizens, and (4) to aid in providing data from Delaware to be used by the Cooperative League Bank Implementation Commission.

The results of the survey will determine the role the Land Grant Institutions in Delaware will play in providing technical assistance to consumer cooperatives.



The flintlocks must have open iron sights.


Special regulations area trappers are also now permitted to use a .22 caliber rifle or handgun to dispatch animals caught in a trap.
