

Janet Pifer wins 4-H clothing scholarship

REYNOLDSVILLE — A 19-year-old Pennsylvania girl, who made a three-piece man's suit for under \$30, has

been named one of six national winners in the 4-H clothing program.

86A, Reynoldsville, received a \$1,000 scholarship during the 58th National 4-H Congress in Chicago No. 25-29.

Selected by the Cooperative Extension Service, the six winners were presented their awards by Coats & Clark Inc., sponsor of the clothing program.

Pifer, daughter of Mrs. Lois Pifer, is a sophomore at Indiana University of Pennsylvania and plans a career as a home economist.

The Jefferson County girl, an 11-year 4-H member, said the project of making a man's suit for her 18-year-old brother, Brian, helped her learn how to properly fit men's clothing. She said the suit would cost about \$80 in a store.

Pifer has learned how to design her own clothing and earlier this summer created an expensive-looking woman's raincoat for under \$20 that she said would have cost about \$80 if purchased ready-made.

The 4-H'er said that clothing designing "gives me a chance to use my creativity and sewing knowledge."

She has learned to buy good quality fabric on sale, and invested in pressing equipment, as well as a high quality sewing machine.

Pifer said that she makes about 90 percent of her own clothing, as well as some

clothing for her two brothers and four sisters.

A teen leader in the local 4-H sewing club for the past four years, she started a new sewing club that has 15 members.

She also has been a member of the 4-H clothing judging team and last year won first place in individual competition at the district level.

Her other projects have included leadership, health photography, food-nutrition bicycle and conservation of national resources.

The 4-H awards program is arranged by National 4-H Council.

The new Legislative Committee Chairman is a Washington County dairyman.

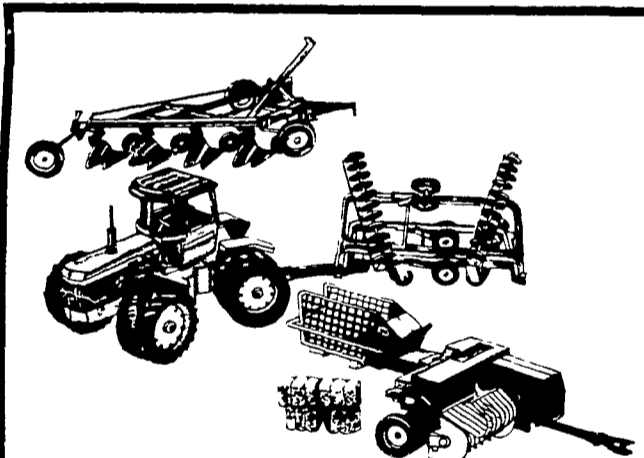
Vernon Cox, West Alexander, also brings to his new position a wide range of experience in activities off his 500 acre farm.

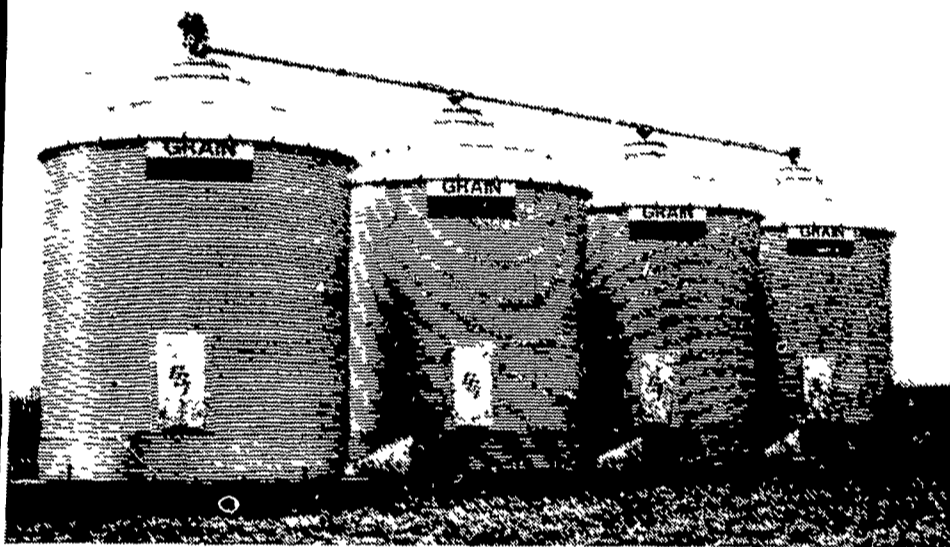

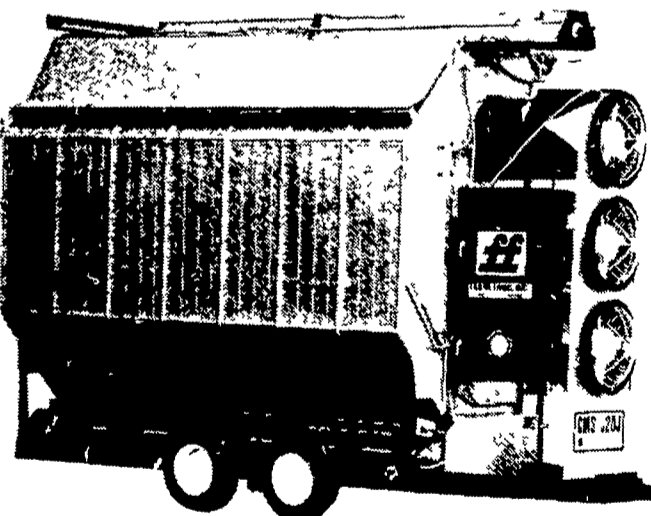
