State egg output at 309 million

HARRISBURG — October 1979 egg production in Pennsylvania totaled 309 million, according to the Pennsylvania Crop Reporting Service.

The October production was five percent above the 293 million eggs produced in October 1978. The October average of 14.9 million layers was seven percent higher than a year ago. Egg production per 100 layers

was 2,077 compared with 2,117 in October 1978.

The nation's laying flocks produced 5.79 billion eggs during October 1979, one percent more than a year ago. The number of layers during October average 287 million compared with 285 million in October 1978. Egg production per 100 layers during the month was 2,016 compared with 2,011 a year ago.
