Poultry Federation tables insurance decision

LANCASTER — At a recent meeting of its Board of Directors the Pennsylvania Poultry Federation assessed the proposition for providing group life insurance as a service for members.

Directors considered a specific proposal developed and presented by professional insurance men.

Decision was postponed pending further study, but several allied industry men

agreed to take the figures back to their respective companies for cost comparisons, and later report reaction to the Board.

In a move endorsing an earlier recommendation of the three Federation Councils — Egg, Broiler, and Turkey — the Board voted unanimously to take a group subscription to "Poultry Times" for one year, promising evaluation after that period. This means the

Federation's 530 members, plus all new members, will receive this weekly industry newspaper during 1980 as a Federation service.

In addition to anticipating more intensive reporting of Pennsylvania poultry activities on a regular basis, the newspaper will feature a column once a month which will be prepared by the Federation staff and aimed at the Pennsylvania poultry industry.

In other business, fund raising banquet co-chairman Bill Carlin reported that preliminary ticket sales are going well and that the recordbreaking attendance goal of 1600 looks attainable.

"We're finding that people who last year bought two tickets are planning now on four or more. Some others who bought one table last year are increasing their orders to two. In the field, I find early enthusiasm for our April gala affair is running high," Carlin noted.

Carlin, chairman of the Federation's scholarship committee also told the Board his committee will soon meet with the Virginia Poultry Federation staff to review that group's program as a prelude to improving the Pennsylvania Federation's present scholarship activities.

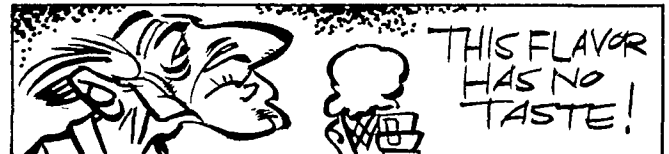
