negative static pressure inside the poultry house.

Direct air over birds first when it is fresh, then move it over manure in pits to dry manure to below 25 percent moisture inside the poultry house.

Design and re-design a ventilation system so that a minimum of one cubic foot of air per minute is moved into and out of the house for every four pounds of bird weight, all day and all night all year long

Poultry houses should be tight, well insulated, and well ventilated.

To save energy, use body

that exhaust fans pull a heat, air convection, gravity, and solar radiation when possible.

> In case of long term electrical power failure (several days), have a gravity air flow system as a standby or an auxiliary generator to generate power In hot weather, it may be necessary to move as much as one cubic foot of air per minute per pound of bird using electrically powered fan ventilation.

Some flock management specialists say if there is no air pollution from manure in a house we can move less air in summer and it will be adequate
