The Fed cattle trade followed an uneven pattern during the week under review. Firm prices prevailed on the opening session under a generally good demand; however, prices were forced downward on Tuesday, with steers under greatest pressure. Part of the downturn was regained at midweek on a curtailed supply. Yield grade was a major price-determining factor and most interests were not particularly aggressive for numbers beyond close up requirements in view of poor movement of the finished product. There was a fairly liberal percentage choice steers and heifers on offer, although many were Mixed 3-4 yield grade and some carried a modest amount of mud. Slaughter steers made up approximately 51 pct. and heifers 29 pct. cows comprised 11 pct. and feeders 6 pct.
