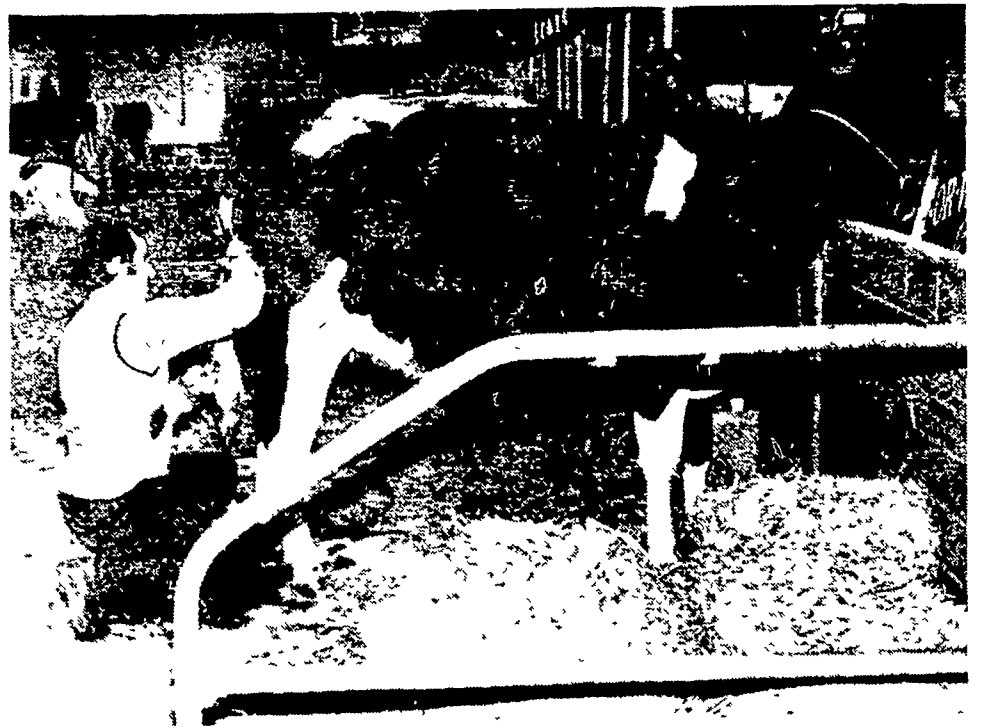


Farm Show: the way it was



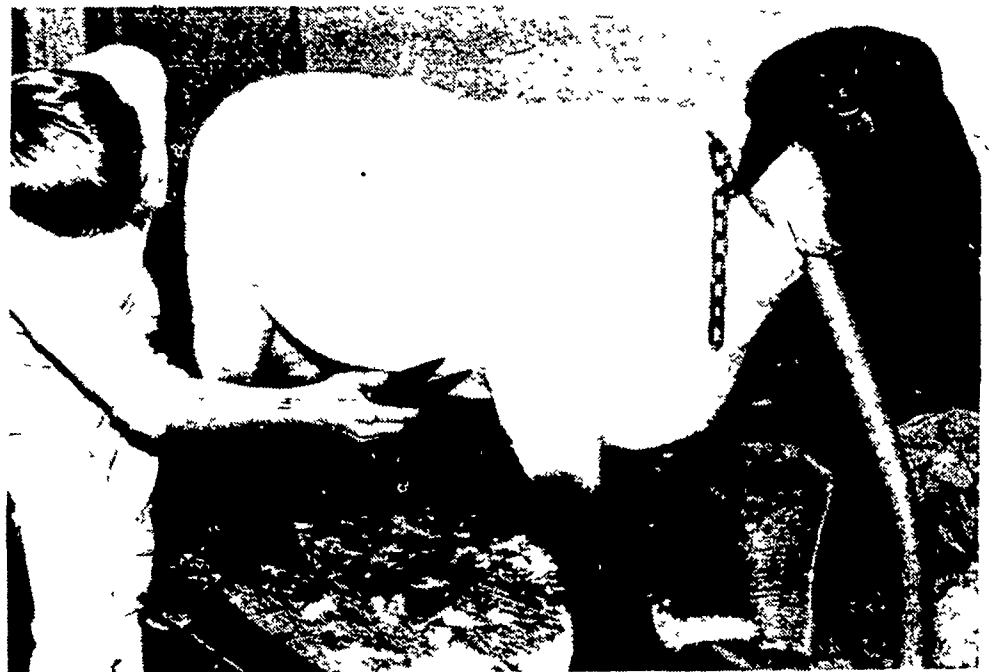

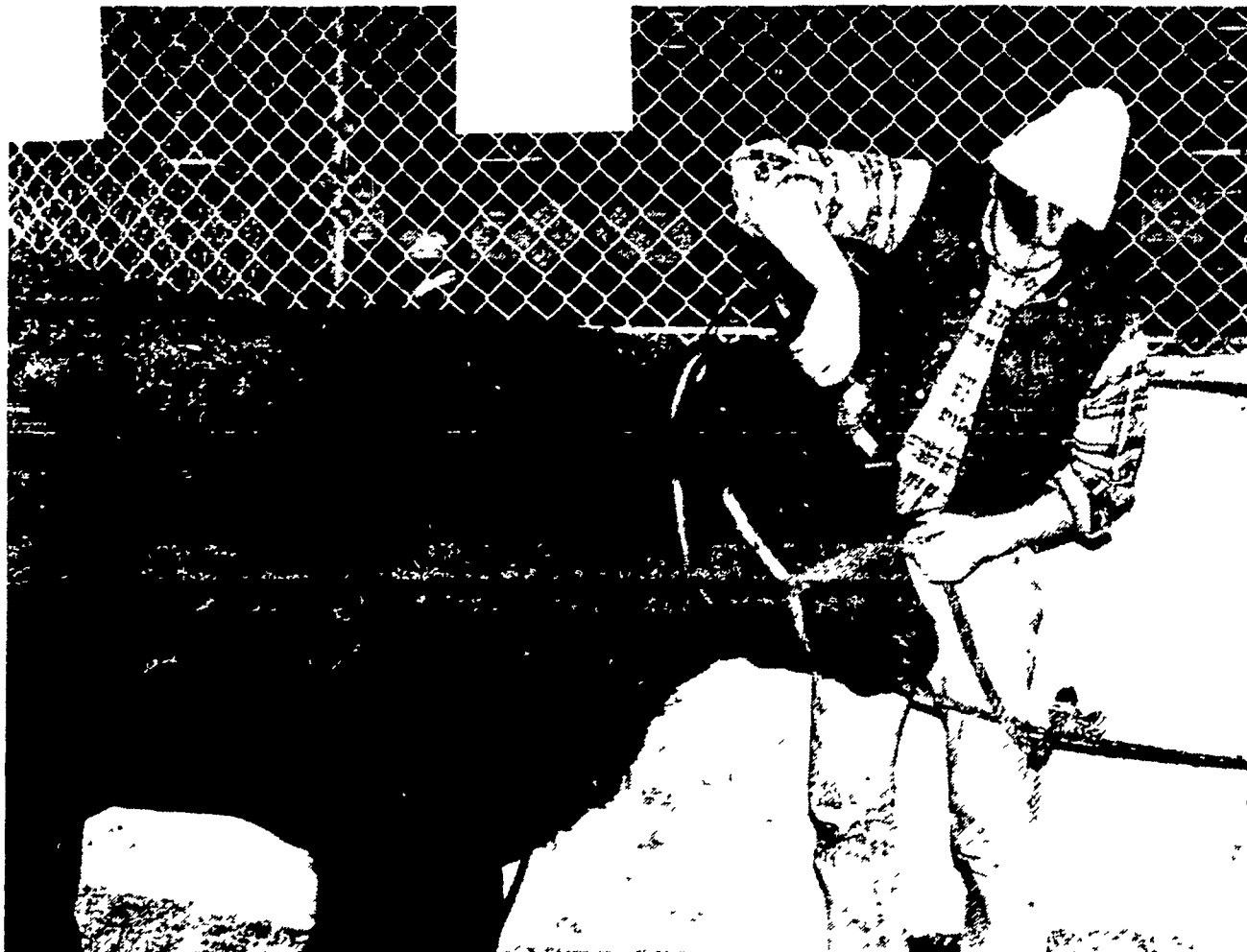
