# McCorkel makes high corn yield

**CARLISLE —** Lloyd McCorkel of R6 Carlisle, achieved a yield of 196.91 bushels per acre in his local corn growing program.

McCorkel used Funk's G-4636 in his high yielding one acre plot.

His fertility program consisted of 148.75 pounds of nitrogen, 59.5 pounds of phosphorus, and 26.25 pounds of potash.

He chisel plowed in the fall and disked in the spring. Atrazine and Dual were used

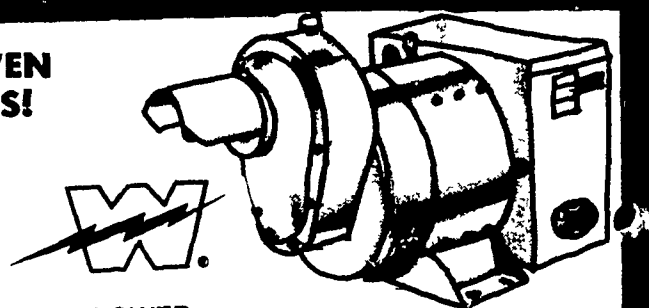
for weed control. The crop was planted on May 1, in 30 inch rows at a population of 26,100 plants per acre using a plateless planter. Furdan was applied for insect control.

His crop was harvested as shelled corn on October 31 from his one acre plot. His harvest population was 23,800 plants per acre.

Crop moisture was 20.0 percent and the yield was adjusted to 15.5 percent moisture.

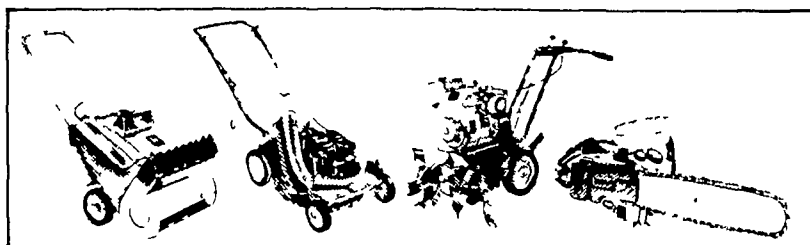
