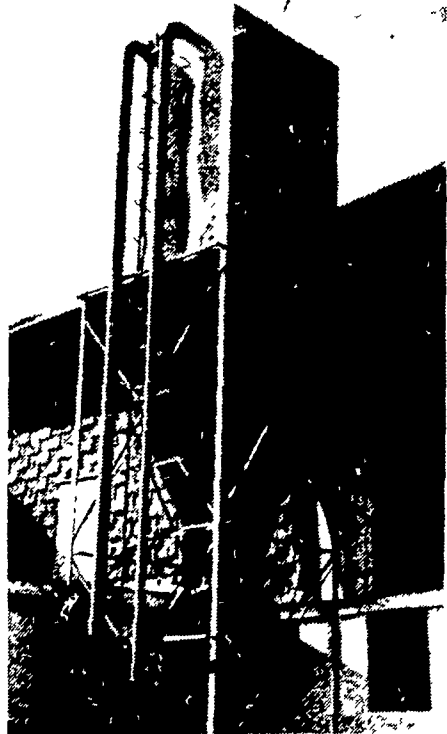
Representative Robert Walker will be the evening's speaker. All Lancaster County pork producers are invited to attend.
