



Cumberland County Dairy Herd Improvement records show that 4,982 5 cows in 80 herds were on production testing in December according to Duane G. Duncan, County Agent.

Of the 69 Herds on DHIA, 34 herds had an average fat production of 150 pounds per cow per day for the month. During the month 76 completed their 305 day lactation with 600 lbs of butterfat.
