Boost forage output on marginal acres

UNIVERSITY PARK — produces only about 25 percent of its potential, yet Most of this country's land

the same land indirectly accounts for almost a third of our food supply—in the form of meat and milk. Grass and range land make up more than half the total in the United States and over 60 percent of the acres is on farms. Yet, only one out of 10 of those acres gets any fertilization.

"The sky is the limit as far as the future use of fertilizer is concerned", according to John E. Baylor, extension agronomist at Penn State.

Fertilization yields a return of \$3 for every dollar invested, however, to most forage producers the profit incentive remains obscure, clouded behind the indirect

use of most forage crops.

The obscurity results from the low income priority farmers place on forage. Since money comes from the sale of milk or meat a certain amount of difficulty arises in attributing the increased yield and quality to fertilization.

Farmers lack confidence in fertilization as a means to increased production. This lack of fertilization results in an under utilization of most of the forage land in this country producing only one quarter of the potential yield while proper management could quadruple production, Baylor said.
