

Delaware to run small farmer workshop

MIDDLETOWN, Del. — Farming a few acres can be fun and profitable if you know how to go about it properly. A workshop will be held Tuesday, February 19, at 7:30 p.m. at the Middletown High School for New Castle County residents who

live on small farms and are interested in making them more productive.

Its purpose is to help these folks become better acquainted with some of the agencies in the state which can help them in their farming efforts.

The workshop is being sponsored by the Soil Conservation Service, Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service, State Forest Service, Farmers Home Administration and the Delaware

Cooperative Extension Service.

After meeting with senior officials from each of these agencies, the workshop will break up into small discussion groups on the following topics.

Soil conservation and soil improvement;
Income from your forest;
Growing Christmas trees;
Growing small fruits and vegetables;
Livestock management on a few acres;
Beekeeping.

Each session will be led by a qualified person who will discuss in general terms how a small farmer might be able to improve his or her income in terms of that particular topic. The idea is not to give detailed information, but to stimulate interest and to show you where you can get further help if you need it.

The workshop is free and open to all interested individuals.

He has been cited for his superior performance many times by his supervisors and by the Maryland Secretary of Agriculture.

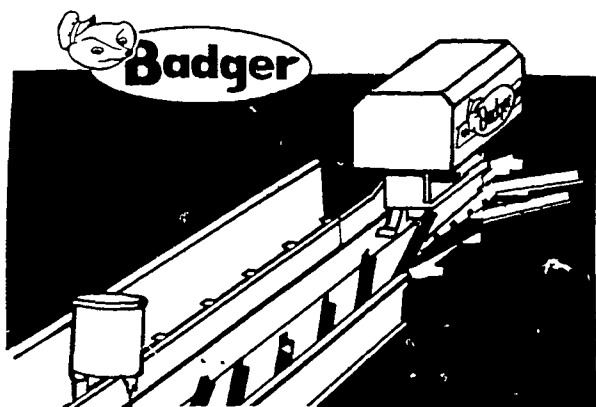
Brode has been a Meat and Poultry Inspector with the state for the past 11 years. He is married and the father of a daughter. The family resides in Cumberland.

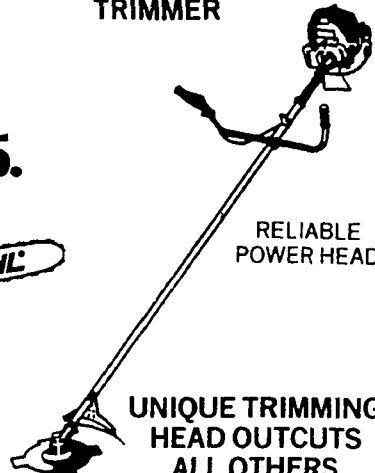
