CHICAGO, Ill. — The FFA's energy conservation program, THE PRESIDENT'S CHALLENGE, will receive a solid boost through the sponsorship of the Estech General Chemicals Corporation, FFA officials have announced.

Estech's involvement is expected to aid member attention focused on the FFA's acceptance of a challenge from U.S. President Jimmy Carter to provide leadership to assist in solving the energy problem. FFA chapters and members across America are currently developing and conducting a wide range of activities which will bring a better understanding of America's energy situation, an increased awareness of energy conservation and an understanding of food and energy relationships. Carter issued the challenge to the FFA when he hosted top FFA leaders in the White House Rose Garden in July of 1979.

"We are quite pleased to

provide additional incentive for such a fine organization to tackle an extremely difficult problem," said Edward Vrablik, President of Estech General Chemicals Corporation.

Estech will provide a \$400 grant of the four regional winners that is to be used by the FFA chapter to improve or expand local FFA projects in: 1) energy; 2) supervised occupational experience programs, or 3)

leadership activities. In addition, Estech General will provide plaques and partial travel stipends for the four regional winning chapters.

Only one FFA chapter of over 8,000 in the nation will receive the President's Challenge Award, but through Estech's sponsorship, all four of the regional winners will now be recognized with an award.

Presentation of the President's Challenge Award is currently planned for the week of July 28 - August 1, 1980 in the Rose Garden of the White House. This falls during the Washington State President's Conference, a week of meetings for the State FFA Association Presidents that is devoted to leadership training and development.

Delmarva to hold safety seminar

DELMAR, Md. — The Third Annual Delmarva Safety Seminar will be held on Tuesday, February 26, 1980, at the Del-Mar-Va Conventional Hall, Route 13, Delmar, Maryland.

It is sponsored by the Delaware Extension Service, in cooperation with the Delmarva Safety Association, Delmarva Poultry Industry, and Maryland Extension Service.

The program this year emphasizes occupational

safety and health in the workplace.

Last year 5.5 million workers were injured on the job, resulting in an estimated \$23 billion in lost wages, medical expenses, insurance claims, and productivity delays.

In addition to the task of accident prevention, business and industry today face the infinitely more complex and subtle challenge of maintaining occupational health. The toll in work-related diseases

indicates there are many serious hazards facing workers, so speakers will be on hand to address such health-related topics such as noise, environmental monitoring, respiratory protection, and medical screening.

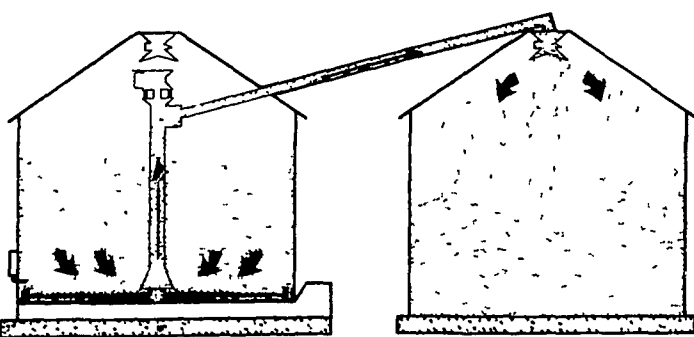

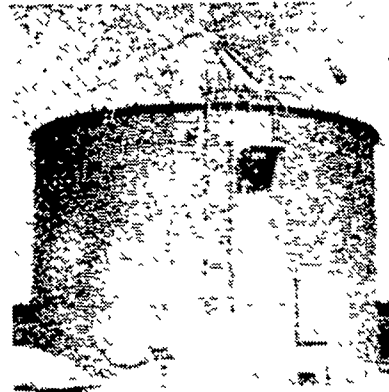
