Speaker for the evening will be Ronald Bard, Assistant Manager of the Lancaster Office of Production Credit Association and Federal Land Bank.

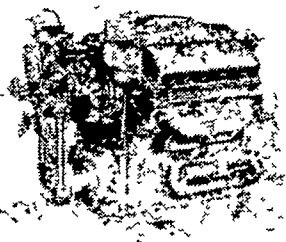

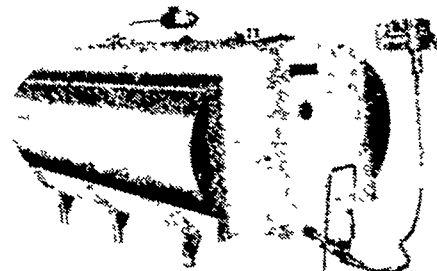

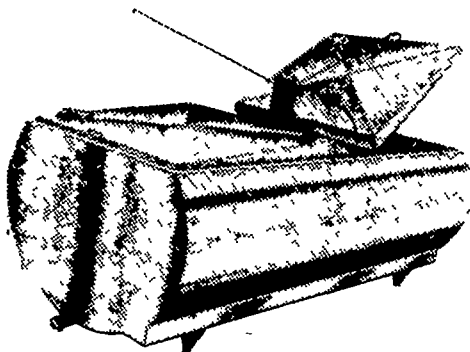
