White House Family Forum seeks delegates

NORRISTOWN — Anyone can apply to be a delegate to The White House Conference on Families in Baltimore June 5, 6 and 7. An application must be received by one of the Forum offices on or before March 12.

Family members, as well as educators, agency representatives and policymakers are urged to send in their applications soon.

President Carter created The White House Conference on Families "to see what we can do, not simply as a government, but as a nation, to strengthen American families." The White House Conference on Families will culminate in three conferences during June and July of 1980 in Baltimore, Minneapolis and Los Angeles.

Pennsylvania is allotted 81 delegates to the Baltimore convention. The state's activities in preparation for the Baltimore meeting included four regional

hearings in Wilkes-Barre, State College, Philadelphia, and Pittsburgh.

In addition, anyone may organize a local family forum. Recommendations from these local forums or meeting in churches, schools, community centers will also comprise Pennsylvania's contribution to The White House Conference.

Groups, organizations, agencies or individuals wishing to sponsor a family forum can obtain resource material from the Montgomery County Extension Office, 400 Markley Street, Norristown, PA 19401. Forums can be held now through April, 1980.

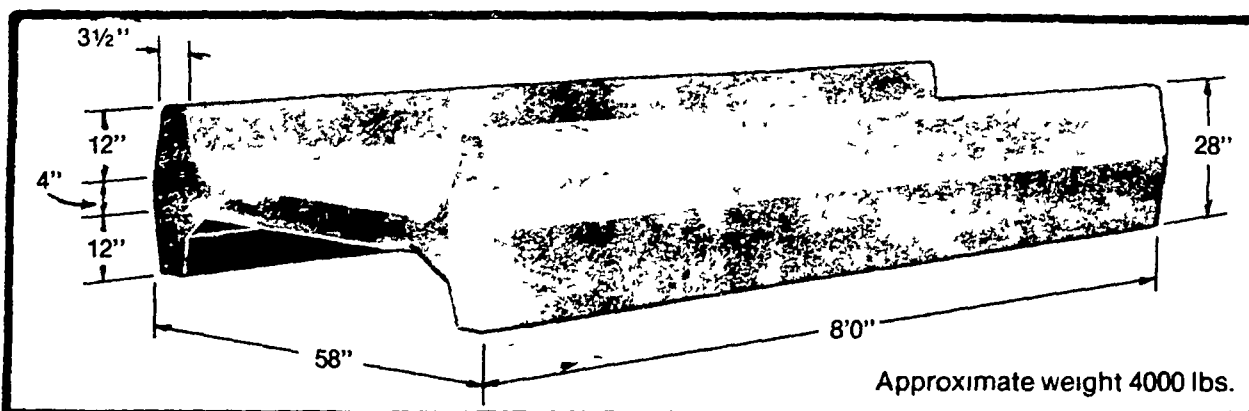
