LANCASTER — The Lancaster County Conservation District's Annual Tree Seedling Sale is going to be closing on March 12. If you are interested in purchasing tree seedlings, there are supplies of all seedlings still available.

The District is offering the following hardwood seed-

lings for sale: White Dogwood, Sugar Maple, Red Oak, Black Walnut, and White Birch. These average in size from 8" to 24" in size and each cost one dollar.

Evergreen seedlings are also being offered. For \$2.50 you receive a packet of 10 seedlings of the following: White Pine, Scotch Pine, Blue Spruce, Norway Spruce, Douglas Fir.

Also, Hemlock seedlings can be purchased for \$5.00 for 10. Hemlocks range in size from 12-20" while the other evergreens are 6-16".

Anyone can purchase seedlings and order any quantity and species they like.

The seedlings are being offered to landowners to beautify their properties and also to improve our environment.

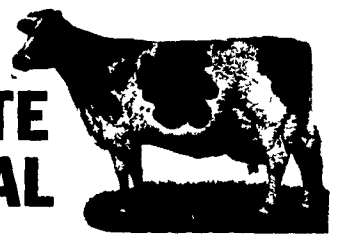
